**ACTIVITIES REPORT**

The Activities were developed at the Department of Jurisprudence of the Università degli Studio di Siena, within the main activities in the teaching mobility. I had the opportunity to teach within the course of International Law of human rights and culture, taught by the Professor Federico Lenzerini. His classes are mainly about cases of international law in the African, American and European HR systems; likewise, I was able to participate in Professor Riccardo Pavoni's classes on international law and European Union law, in which I was able to make a presentation on the inter-American human rights system.



Also, I could attend law classes in Italian language; its content was mainly on the regulation of international law, systems and sources of law. I also learned about class dynamics are given, highlighting the presentation of cases, made mainly by students, and the magisterial class.

In these academic scenarios I managed to highlight the characteristics of Erasmus mobility and the benefits it offers such as the exchange of culture and learning. On the other hand, I showed the advantages of the clinical method in teaching and studying law as a novelty that we have in our University compared to the way of teaching in Siena, which is more traditional.



Likewise, I attended a class taught by Francesco Francioni, an Italian professor with wide recognition in international law. At the same time, I had the opportunity to take cultural trips, which helped me to recognize relevant sites in the legal field and Italian traditions.

I got a lot of background on the legal traditions and they let me witness the greatness of the historical sites that can not be appreciated in any other way than by visiting them; among them, I met the ruins of Pompeii, Naples, Rome, Florence, Venice, Siena and the Vatican state as well.



## RESULTS

As relevant results, I could highlight the following:

- Learning in different class techniques: give greater participation to students through the presentation of cases of different systems of protection of human rights.
- Learning class topics: deeply understanding, and recognizing the European reality, the legal framework of the European Union.
- Università degli Studi di Siena interuniversity agreement – UNAB: It stands out as a great achievement of Erasmus participation, the interest shown by the Università degli Studio di Siena in concluding an inter-institutional agreement that will benefit teachers, researchers, undergraduate and postgraduate students of the UNAB interested in developing studies in Siena.



Finally, I want to express that among the experiences I've lived, this will be the one I will always treasure in my heart, the kind welcoming in Siena and the general experience of this Erasmus meeting, has provided me many reasons to consider myself grateful and with the certainty that in life you receive more than what you want, at the appropriate time.
